Safety & Security Procedures

CPR & First Aid for Infants & Children (\$125)

Both American Red Cross CPR and First Aid for Infants & Children certifications are valid for 2 years.

Health and Safety (\$250)

This training is **required** to become registered or licensed as a Family or Group Family Child Care Provider in New York State.

Infectious Disease Control (\$50)

This workshop illustrates how to recognize, manage and prevent infectious diseases in your child care settings while explaining the procedures as per state in other related **health issues**.

Medication Administration Training (\$250)
