

# Early Childhood Education Career Pathways

## **Group Teacher in Pre-K Classroom**

#### **Initial Certificate**

- Required Workshops<sup>123</sup>
- Fingerprint Clearance
- •US Citizen/Permanent Resident
- Bachelor's Degree (BA)4
- Qualifying score on EAS, CST Multi-Subject, and edTPA<sup>5</sup>
- Valid 5 years, can be renewed ONE time for 5 more years, MUST lead to getting Professional Certificate
- •May work as Group Teacher without BA under approved Study Plan IF you have<sup>7</sup>:
- Associate's (AA or AS) degree<sup>5</sup> including practicum OR
- •90 or more undergraduate college credits<sup>5</sup> and 1 year teaching in PreK-2nd grade OR
- BA in other academic subject area AND 1 year teaching Prek-3rd grade
- Study plan can be valid for 7 years and might be renewed

#### **Professional Certificate**

- •All previous requirements for Initial Certificate plus...
- Master's Degree in Early Childhood Education<sup>5</sup>
- •3 years paid experience as Group Teacher under Initial Certificate
- •1 year of mentored experience<sup>6</sup>
- Valid permanently with continuing professional development, 100 hours every 5 years

### **Child Care Center Director**

#### Initial Certificate

- Also referred to as the "Provisional Certificate"
- •All previous requirements for Initial Certificate plus...
- •Master's Degree in Early Childhood Education<sup>5</sup>
- •3 years work experience as a Group Teacher for children under age of 6 years old
- Valid 5 years, can be renewed up to 2 times for a total of 10 more years under specific circumstances, MUST lead to getting Professional Certificate
- May work as a Center Director (MA level) with only BA under approved Study Plan to fulfill Permanent Certificate requirements<sup>7</sup>
- Study plan can be valid for 7 years, might be renewed

#### Professional Certificate

- Also referred to as a "Permanent Certificate"
- All previous requirements for Initial Certificate plus...
- Qualifying score on NYSED School Building Leader (Rev. 2013)
   Exam: Part 1 & Part 2
- •3 years paid full-time administrative experience
- Valid permanently with required professional development
- May substitute a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership for the Master's Degree in Early Childhood Education

Certificate requirements are NYSED regulated; however in NYC, child care centers must follow DOHMH Article 47 regulations and are still subject to NYSED.
