Safety & Security Procedures

CPR & First Aid for Infants & Children (\$125)

Both American Red Cross CPR and First Aid for Infants & Children certifications are valid for 2 years.

Health and Safety (\$250)

This training is **required** to become registered or licensed as a Family or Group Family Child Care Provider in New York State.

Infectious Disease Control (\$50)

This workshop illustrates how to recognize, manage and prevent infectious diseases in your child care settings while explaining the procedures as per state in other related health issues.

Medication Administration Training (\$250)

This training is required for child care providers to administer medication to children in their programs.
